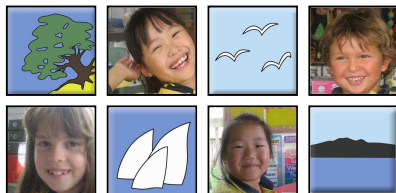


Milford School was opened in 1926 and is a well established school situated on the shores of Lake Pupuke on Auckland's North Shore.
